


### Playing Trivia


Friends or relatives who are unable to attend the funeral in person can still be part of the chapel service by watching and listening from anywhere in the world via the live web-stream or Zoom.






Having a memorial stone made for a loved one can be such an important part of the grieving process and there is something truly gratifying in being able to provide such a service.

Friends or relatives who are unable to attend in person can still be part of the service by watching and listening from anywhere in the world via live web-streaming.




The adjoining function suite on site allows families to adjourn for refreshments immediately after the service, thus keeping everyone together.
