Friends or relatives who are unable to attend the funeral in person can still be part of the chapel service by watching and listening from anywhere in the world via the live web-stream or Zoom.



A crowning moment

On March 3rd I received an e-mail inviting me to the Coronation. Initially I assumed it was a hoax, but news soon filtered out that Charles wanted 450 British Empire Medal to be randomly selected and I was one of the lucky ones.





Unfortunately, I'd already booked a holiday down in Benalmadena from May 2nd to May 12th with my wife. After much consideration, the best plan was to fly back from Spain the night before and then return the following afternoon. At only £90 return plus the cost of a night at a Gatwick hotel I wasn't going to pass up this unique opportunity.

My official invite arrived on April 20th, and included detailed instructions on timings, what to wear, what to bring and what not to bring! The night before the Coronation I kissed my wife goodbye at 7pm and headed to Malaga airport for my flight back to Gatwick.

The week before I'd been contacted by the BBC who wanted to interview a few BEM holders before and after the Coronation. It meant a 6.30am meet so I left my Gatwick hotel at 5.30am and arrived on time after a 15 minute walk from Victoria Station. I met the others selected for the interviews which included young 13 year old Max from Devon who'd raised money by camping in his tent for 3 years during Covid. I was interviewed by the BBC royal correspondent Daniela Relph. She was very nice and was interested in my flying in from Spain story. It didn't go out live so unsure if it will ever see the light of day.

At 8.30am I entered the Abbey and was sat 6 rows back in the Nave. From 9.00am we were treated to an amazing concert which included choral, orchestral, soloists and organ music. All the time, the great and the good were being ushered to their reserved seats. The First Lady, Ant and Dec, all previous Prime Ministers, members of the Commonwealth, other Royal families from around the world and Lionel Ritchiel.

A card on our seat reminded us to keep our conversations respectfully quiet as we waited for the arrival of the royal family. William and Kate looked amazing and then with great fanfare Charles and Camilla arrived. I was about 4 yards away as they passed up the aisle towards the inner sanctum. I followed the proceedings via the 50 page order of service that I will treasure for ever. Lots of rites, rituals, readings, choral pieces and a short sermon before the crowning moment. You could've heard a pin drop as Justin Welby placed the historic crown on King Charles head. The Abbey then in unison proclaimed God Save the King.... quite a moment.

After 2 hours the service ended and the procession out of the Abbey began. After about 15 minutes we were able to move. and I ended up behind Rishi Sunak and his wife. I headed back to the media area for a post ceremony interview with Daniela where I expressed my overwhelming feeling of being so fortunate to have been part of history. The rain had started by then and I made quickly for the underground back to Victoria. I retrieved my bag from the hotel and did a miraculous toilet change and emerged in flip flops and t-shirt. I boarded the 5.30pm flight back to Malaga. Still clutching the order of service and came through the apartment door at 10pm Spanish time.

Still on a high my wife and I went over to our favourite little bar for a couple of drinks. No one there believed I'd been to the Coronation. Why would they? An unforgettable experience and something I will no doubt bore people with for years to come. I was immensely proud to be there representing H.D. Tribe Ltd and raising the profile of Worthing Charity, Guild Care.
